Rule 64. Seizing a Person or Property

(a) Remedies—~~UNDER STATE LAW~~—in General. At the commencement of and throughout an action, every remedy is available that, under ~~the law of the state~~ law where the court is located, provides for seizing a person or property to secure satisfaction of the potential judgment. ~~But a federal statute governs to the extent it applies.~~

(b) Specific Kinds of Remedies. The remedies available under this rule include the following—~~however designated and regardless of whether state procedure requires an independent action~~:

- (1)• arrest;
- (2)• attachment;
- (3)• garnishment;
- (4)• replevin;
- (5)• sequestration; and
- (6)• other corresponding or equivalent remedies.
