Court Interpreter Training Institute (CITI):

The CITI is an intensive 120-hour Spanish/English training focused on improving interpreting proficiency that is offered every summer. The CITI is held fully online. It is designed to help aspiring and working interpreters hone their skills. Instruction is differentiated to allow both beginning and advanced interpreters to benefit.

Online Translation Certificate

The online translation certificate consists of three 16-week courses focused on Spanish/English legal, medical, and business translation. The courses can be taken individually or consecutively to earn the full certificate.

Judicial and Medical Interpreting Certificate – English/Spanish OR English/Portuguese

This program will be offered online via Zoom for the Fall 2020 semester.

The community need for interpreting is critical. The ability to overcome language barriers is essential in a variety of instances that include medical emergencies as well as legal and social situations. This program is designated to train entry-level interpreters for service and employment opportunities. The instructors—all specialists in their respective fields of interpreting—will incorporate "real life" samples of materials and examples of situations that will be encountered in the field. Consecutive interpreting used in medical, legal, and social service situations, as well as simultaneous and sight translation will be covered. Advanced training for the state exam for Court Interpreters will be offered
